## **LEMO RoHS Compliant Certificate**

On 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2013, Directive 2002/95/EC is repealed by Directive 2011/65/EU known as the recast of the RoHS Directive or as the RoHS 2 Directive.

In 2015, Directive 2015/863, known as RoHS 3, was published by the EU expanding the scope of the actual Directive by adding 4 additional restricted substances (phthalates) to the existing list of 6.

This last Directive bans, as of 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2019, the introduction of products that contain an excess of allowable concentrations of now 10 identified hazardous chemicals:

- 6(a) Lead as an alloying element in steel for machining purposes and in galvanised steel containing up to 0,35 % lead by weight.
- 6(c) Copper alloy containing up to 4 % lead by weight.
